### JURISDICTION


4. Intervenor have a justiciable interest in this case. Intervenor are respectively three of the many investors the State of Texas references in its original Verified Petition and amendments thereto. The Intervenor have a material interest in this case by virtue of the fact that they are some of the alleged “victims,” and the Receiver is in possession of funds and insurance policies which Intervenor hold an interest in. The Intervenor desire to contribute toward a successful resolution of this receivership, particularly since such resolution would be to their interest. Further, Intervenor will seek, by separate motion, to establish a committee of investors to work with the Receiver, the parties and the Court to seek the most successful outcome to the investors. Further, such committee will seek to establish communication protocols for investors.

5. The Intervenor also have a material interest in this case because they may hold individual claims similar to the Receiver’s claims, and, if such claims exist, judicial economy would be served to maintain such claims in this action.

Intervenor pray for all relief to which they are entitled, in law or equity that they may show they are entitled to.
